Club Overview 2018-19

The Club shoots on the North Sports Field at Ditchling Recreation Ground on Lewes Road, Ditchling.

We meet every Sunday, from 9.00 onwards, with the facility to shoot all day if desired (at all times complying with the terms of Archery GB's insurance requirements).

During the summer, we shoot Wednesday and Thursday evenings from 17.00 until dusk (weather permitting).

During the winter, we shoot indoors in Lindfield on a Monday evening and have the opportunity to shoot with several other local clubs on other evenings in the week.

Fees

Our Membership (Shooting) year runs from 1st October 2017 to 30th September 2018.

In line with the County, Region and National governing bodies, we operate a pro-rata system throughout the year.

We will need to assess you before accepting your membership to the club. Please see 'Joining the Club' below.

Upon payment of the fees, you will be required to complete a membership form which we will forward to you after assessment.

Coaching

The Club has a number of qualified coaches who are on hand to provide advice when requested. The Club also arranges training days for the membership.

Joining the Club

We assess prospective members before acceptance into the Club, either:

1. If you have never received beginners training from an Archery GB trained instructor/coach, then we insist on attendance at one of these courses. The Club runs beginner's courses during the year. We are also happy to accept people from other club's courses, provided there is sufficient evidence to confirm this. If you would like to participate in a beginner's course run by the Club, then please contact the Beginners Course Organiser.
2. If you are a "returning" archer, we conduct a simple test to ensure that you are safe to shoot and understand range safety.

Juniors

The Club welcomes juniors from the age of 8, with club rules requiring that juniors up to the age of 15 are accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.
