USE OF DATA COLLECTED ON THIS FORM:

The data and information which you enter will be used by the Club to administer your Membership, keep track of your development as an archer, and to contact you from time to time to keep you informed about Club Activities. We will not share your personal data with anyone else, except as stated below, which is an essential part of your participation in the sport, and among other things provides compulsory insurance.

This club is affiliated to Archery GB which is the national governing body for archery in Great Britain, and to the Southern Counties Archery Society which is the regional body, and to the Sussex County Archery Association which is the county body. It is a condition of our affiliation with all these bodies that all our members must also be affiliated members of the three bodies. Unless you are already affiliated to AGB, SCAS and SCAA by virtue of being a member of another Archery Club, when you become a member of this club, or renew membership, your subscription will include the affiliation charges of any of the bodies you are not already a member of, and you will be automatically affiliated to those bodies.

The Club will share your membership details with the bodies, which will mean that you will be eligible to take part in County, Regional and National Events and eligible to win Awards. You will also be eligible to apply for grants and benefit from Coaching and Judging supported by these bodies, and could even be chosen to represent County, Region, Home Nation or Great Britain and Northern Ireland. Benefits of affiliating to Archery GB include Insurance Cover, a quarterly magazine delivered to your home address, and if you opt-in, e-bulletins delivered to your device from time to time, and opportunities to win a variety of performance and improvement awards from Novice to Grand Master.
