10 members of Ditchling archery club went to the SCAS -SCAA indoor championships at the K2 leisure centre in Crawley on Sunday the 6th March 2011. They were Abigail Goacher, Ben Green, Bob Darling, Cliff Knapp, Garry Sillet, Hannelore Wurtz, John Humphrey, Pete Aldis, Petra Ginman and Tim Parmenter.

The individual competition was a Portsmouth round. This was over 2 session with 33 bosses 66 targets and 2 details. There was well over 200 archers who took part and this made for some nice footwork on the equipment line to avoid treading on anyone's bow.
